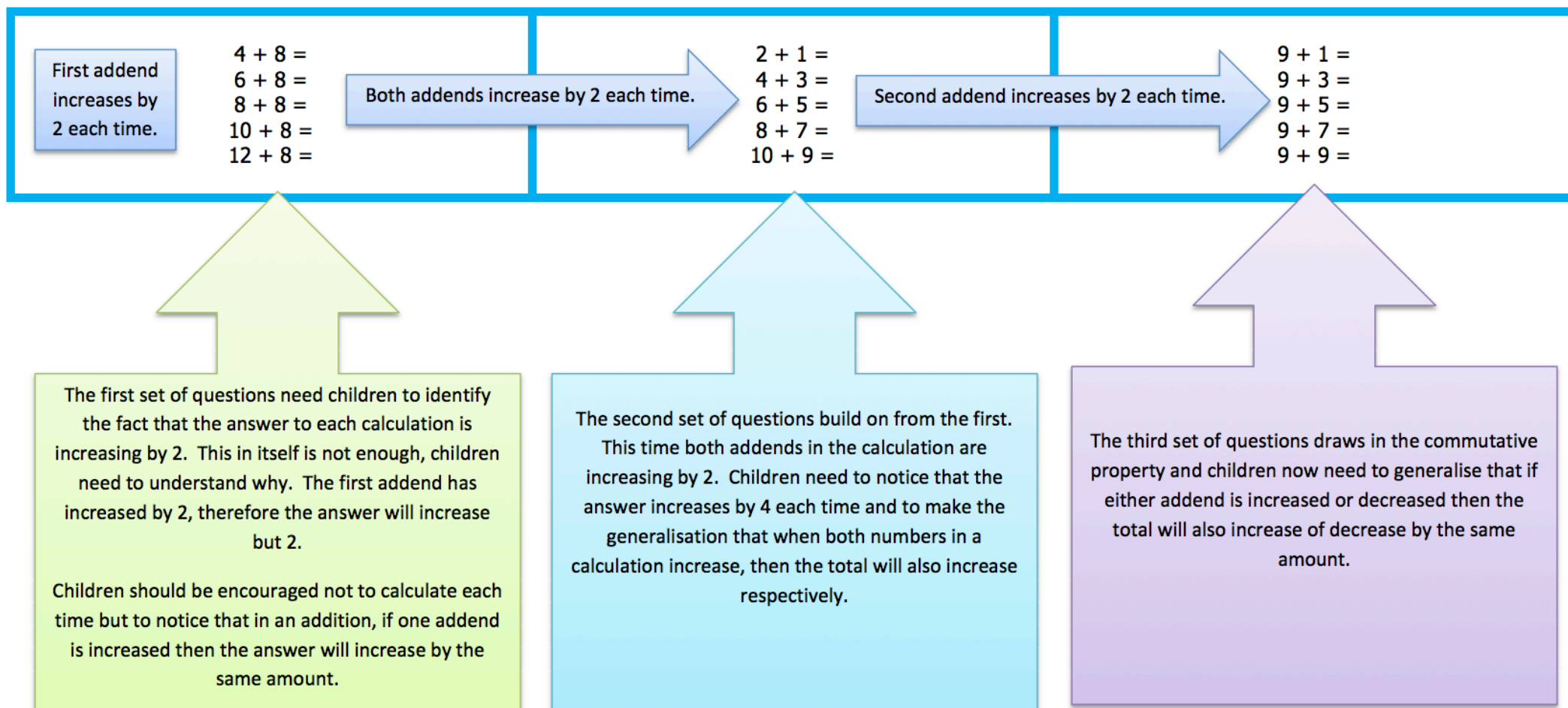


## Procedural Variation

Procedural Variation provides the opportunity to reveal the structure of the mathematics being explored. A carefully designed set of questions, that will draw children's attention to a particular aspect of mathematics. Procedural variation cannot happen in isolation. It needs to be accompanied by careful teaching that supports children to notice key structures and to discuss the ideas mathematically.
